## **UNWELCOME ATTENDEES @ SCHOOL**



Some refer to schools as a breeding ground for germs. They can also be a breeding ground for unwelcome attendees such as lice and bed bugs.

According to the Centers for Disease Control, it is estimated that 6-12 million head lice infestations occur each year, primarily among school age children between 3-11 years old.



Although primarily spread by direct contact with an infested person, lice can also be spread by contact with hats, coats, or fabric as they can live one to two days after falling off their host.

**Bed bugs are notorious hitch-hikers** as they attach themselves to bags and clothing. They are also very good at hiding and once they become embedded in a dark, small space they reproduce rapidly.

With students returning to school after vacation time, it increases the chance of a bed bug infestation through the transfer on backpacks. Just ask the maintenance crew at Thornwood High School outside Chicago.

Earlier this year when students returned from winter break travels, they experienced a bed bug infestation which took months to eradicate.

Although summer is winding down, temperatures are still warm, which leads to an overabundance of pesky outdoor insects. Late summer/early fall insects can be bothersome at best in the case of spiders and cockroaches. However, they can also be dangerous for outdoor workers, particularly those operating electrical equipment, with threatening wasps and yellow jackets.

Some of those pests which are seen surging in the late summer/early fall include cockroaches, spiders, wasps & yellow jackets, ticks, mosquitoes, ants, and bed bugs.

Make sure you are using the right insecticide for the pests you need to address by referring to our Insecticide Kill Chart. Download it for a complete listing of pests each product will address.

## WINTER STORAGE OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT

If you're in construction, landscaping or fleet management, chances are you'll be storing some large equipment during the winter months. Taking winterizing steps now will save effort in the spring when work gets into full swing.

There are some common steps to take when preparing for winter storage, whether indoor or outdoor, however it is always advised to refer to owner's manuals for specifics.

If the equipment will be dormant for more than three months, most recommend **draining the fuel as gasoline can expire after that time;** it thickens and then clogs up the gas tanks and carburetor ports.

It is important to clean everything before putting equipment into storage, making sure to remove dirt and debris. After cleaning, it is best to confirm that all moving parts are well-lubricated. A popular choice is a lithium-based grease, such as L1070 MR. JOE Amber Premium Lithium E.P. Grease as it is pumpable at low temperatures and resists chemical breakdown and oxidation.



**Check for any chips in the paint where metal is exposed and corrosion can take hold.** Either cover those chips with paint or apply a protective coating, such as **5611 AVERT Corrosion Inhibitor** is designed for indoor storage. For long-lasting outdoor protection and indefinite indoor protection, rely on **5540 DEFENSE EF Metal Parts Protector**. Both products coat the surface and prevents moisture to penetrate. Keep in mind that engine parts like cylinders, pumps and gears particularly need this extra defense against condensation and humidity during months in storage.

Some compact construction machinery will constantly draw on the battery, so it is recommended to **disconnect the battery and store it in a cool, dry place (above 32° F ). If the battery is not removed, apply a protectant such as 8220 CLINCH Battery Protectant** which prevents corrosion and battery failure when applied to battery terminals, cable ends, wires, bolts, brackets, clamps and other metal components.
